Prime Minister hands over **Arima Police Station**



The Ministry of National Security, via its executing arm, the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service, is upgrading its systems and operations to a standard befitting 21st Century policing to best fight crime.

On Tuesday 26th November 2013, the Honourable Kamla Persad-Bissessar MP, SC, Prime Minister of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago handed over the first of eight police stations, to be delivered in Phase One out of a total programme of 17 Police Stations. The Piarco Police Station is also ready for hand-over. By the end of April 2014, all eight police stations in Phase One would have been completed and ready for hand over.

State-owned Project Management company, the Urban Development Corporation of Trinidad & Tobago Limited (UDeCOTT), was mandated to project manage construction of these new facilities within the National Security portfolio, providing modern, safe, functional, efficient and community-friendly law-enforcement facilities, in the following jurisdictions in Trinidad & Tobago:
